

Civil effectiveness of Null Marriage

Rules the Matrimony civilly null, after declaring it ecclesiastically null, by the court of 1st instance nº 9 of Valencia. (*Juzgado de Primera Instancia número 9 de Valencia*), taking ecclesiastical effect by the Ecclesiastical Court of Valencia on June 13th, 2007 and civil effect on October 10th, 2007, finding under legal grounds the place where they were married to have jurisprudence as well as reviewing the findings of fact. Resulting as **inadmissible** the behavior of Mr. Innes under contempt of court for his opposition to the Ecclesiastic jurisdiction to the request of the court of the Archdiocese of Newark, expecting first a resolution from the civil divorce sentence of the state of New Jersey (USA) granting custody of the minor to the father and thus refusing the judicial ecclesiastic competency which he originally accepted and turned to when marrying.

This sentence is final and irrevocable and cannot be appealed.
